Ofsted no longer provide schools with an overall effectiveness grade (as of September 2024). However, schools inspected in this academic year will receive gradings for sub-categories of inspection.

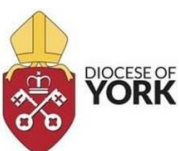
